MESSAGE FROM THE TOWN:

The new year means we begin looking ahead again at Town Hall. Thanks to all those who participated in our public input forums and surveys. The Town Council will be meeting later in January to review the input and ideas we got from that and begin revising our strategic plan and budget for Fiscal Year 2024. As always, the public is invited to be part of that process in person or on zoom.

The Town has received an official application for a development and annexation agreement from the Aspen Meadows developers. This would potentially add over 1700 acres and 1400 residential units to the Town, along with some commercial and ski terrain development. In short, it's a big deal. There will be plenty of public hearings and opportunities to learn all about it along the way as this process unfolds over the upcoming months, but the first one will be at Planning Commission on January 17.

Other happenings around Town: The hotel formerly known Best Western Premiere (formerly, formerly known as the Grand Lodge) is now Brian Head Lodge. There is a new Mexican restaurant opening up at the Mall (where Sook Jai was located), and Sook Jai is working on opening a mobile location behind Town Hall.
