Over the past several months, the Town Council has faced several difficult decisions. One of the most significant was whether to increase property taxes. After careful consideration, we concluded that this is not the right time. We recognize that families and businesses are already feeling the impact of rising costs, and we believe now is the time to tighten our own belt rather than ask more of our residents.

We also considered implementing a Transportation Utility Fee. After extensive discussion, the Council decided not to move forward with that proposal at this time. Instead, we will continue looking for ways to stretch every taxpayer's dollar as far as possible while maintaining the services our community depends on.

The Town will be forming a Community Wildfire Committee to help guide our future wildfire preparedness efforts. This effort will only succeed with community involvement, and we hope you'll consider participating as opportunities become available.

As we celebrate our nation's 250th anniversary, let's remember that while we may not always agree on everything, we have far more in common than what divides us. Our shared commitment to our community and our country is what binds us together. Look for opportunities to make someone else's day just a little better.
